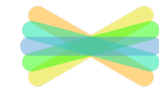

Prior Learning:

In reception children have learnt to recognise that a range of different technology can be used in places such as homes and schools. They will have used ipads to access different software and navigate different websites.

Key Computing Learning:

- Seesaw is an electronic journal where we can create and store information as files.
- In school, we use Seesaw to create and store information about our learning and it can be used to record learning in any subject.
- Seesaw can be used to create, save and store information in different ways including videos, photos and writing.
- Each person in the class has their own profile for Seesaw. This is used to store each person's files safely in one place.
- A login is used to keep information and users safe and secure.
- Seesaw is used online and needs the internet to work.

E-Safety Learning Opportunity:

- We use passwords to keep our information safe and should not share our passwords with other people.
- To protect ourselves we should not share information about ourselves with other people online.
